



## 6 nights - Nkwichi Lodge and Kaya Mawa

Nkwichi Lodge & Kaya Mawa are offering a spectacular new package for those wanting to explore the remote northern territories of Lake Malawi. Explore the magical Likoma Island before gliding across the waters to the stunning, untouched shores on the Mozambique side of the lake. A great Malawi & Mozambique combination - all about the experience!

**Day 1:** On arrival in Lilongwe you will be met and transferred to your flight to Likoma Island – a quick 1 hour hop.

**Day 1 - Day 4:** A short road transfer to the spectacular Kaya Mawa Lodge where you can relax and enjoy your escape from 'The Mainland'. Fill your days with quad biking, scuba diving, snorkeling, and water skiing, relaxing and dining on sumptuous Kaya Mawa meals. Also visit an arts and crafts initiative along with some inspiring community projects set up by Kaya Mawa.

**Day 4:** Transfer by boat to Nkwichi Lodge - roughly a 2 hour cruise from Kaya Mawa (with a short stopover at Malawi immigration and in Cobué to stamp into Mozambique)

**Day 4 - Day 7:** Nkwichi Lodge on the untouched Mozambique shores is an experience in itself with its squeaky white beaches, crystal clear waters and relaxed atmosphere. Explore the pristine; remote shores by canoe, snorkeling, sailing or dhow safari. Renowned for its responsible approach to tourism and development, guests are able to learn of the various projects within the Manda Wilderness Community Conservation Area.

**Day 7:** Transfer by boat back to Likoma Island (via Mozambican and Malawian Immigration) for your charter flight back to Lilongwe to connect with your flight home.
